I. SITUATIONAL OVERVIEW

The weather is fine as of reporting date. Clearing operations to road access in barangay and clearing of falling trees to houses are ongoing since December 17, 2021 (Friday).

The MDRRMO gave initial report, the Rapid Damage And Needs Assessment (RDANA) to DSWD & PDRRMO (18 December), to DILG (19 December), and Sangguniang Bayan of Alegria, Surigao del Norte (20 December).

The Sangguniang Bayan of Alegria, SDN adopted the MDRRMC Resolution recommending the Sangguniang Bayan to declare State of Calamity in the whole Municipality during their session early morning on Monday, December 20, 2021.

II. EFFECTS AND DAMAGE

AFFECTED POPULATION:

- Number of families evacuated: 686
- Number of persons evacuated: 3,276
- Number of totally damaged houses: 574
- Number of partially damaged houses: 2,278

CASUALTY:

Zero casualty as of reporting date

STATUS OF WORK:

The MLGU personnel resume its office works on December 20, 2021 (Monday).



STATUS OF LIFELINES:

Communication via PLDT/SMART and GLOBE signal restored on December 18, 2021 (Saturday) but only on selected part of the municipality especially at Barangay Pongtud and some neighboring parts of barangay in Kitcharao, Agusan del Norte.

3G gasoline station temporarily opened on Saturday, December 18, 2021 and became fully operational on Sunday, December 19, 2021 and close at 8:00PM.

Water supply in the proper areas/barangay are sufficient. However, the affected barangay of Pongtud, Budlingin, and Ombong water supply are still to be under assessment for rehabilitation.

Electrical power system in the whole municipal are still not operating and out of service as of reporting date. The MLGU uses some portable generator set in RHU to preserve the COVID-19 vaccine. Some barangay LGU are utilizing generator set to provide temporary source of electricity for the cellular phone charges and flashlights among others. Some business operations of clearing for falling of trees at houses.

SECURITY STATUS:

No reporting looting incident as of reporting date except last December 16, 2021 on the onset of typhoon as reported by Alegria Municipal Police Office. National roads are already safe from motorist while ongoing operations for clearing of falling trees that damage some houses.


III. ACTION TAKEN

1. Ongoing clearing operations to rescue houses from falling trees in the whole municipality. Clearing of road (national highway and barangay) were completed on December 17-19, 2021.
2. Provision of food relief assistance to some 5,300 families in the whole municipality composed of five (5) kilos of rice spaghetti with ingredients plus ₱100 cash on December 18 (Saturday) and December 19 (Sunday). The MLGU gave one sack of rice per barangay during the Rapid Damage And Needs Assessment (RDANA) on December 17, 2021 (Friday)
3. Conducted RDANA on December 17, 2021 (Friday) composed of three teams with the following:
 - Team 1: Barangay Pongtud, San Juan, Alipao, & San Pedro
 - Team 2: Barangay Poblacion, Anahaw, Gamuton & Julio Ouno
 - Team 3: Barangay Ombong, Budlingin, Camp Eduard, & Ferlda
4. Conducted urgent MDRRMC meeting with Punong Barangay/ Representative afternoon on December 17, 2021 together with RDANA team. The MDRRMC recommended for the declaration of state of calamity in the whole municipality on the said day base on the RDANA report.



5. Conducted initial assessment of the evacuation center during the onset of the typhoon Odette at 5:30PM on December 16, 2021 to barangay except Budlingin, Camp Eduard, and Ferlda. There was initial deployment of team to clear the national roads on the same night.
6. Lobbied to Sangguniang Bayan during its session on Monday, December 20, 2021. The Sangguniang Bayan adopted the MDRRMC resolution declaring state of calamity in the whole municipality.
7. Conducted meeting with MLGU family (all personnel available) on Monday, December 20, 2021. Clearing operations at the Municipal Hall compound. Clearing of some office from debris.
8. Conducted initial Post Damage and Needs Assessment composed of same RDANA team deployed Monday, December 20, 2021. Target of Post Damage and Needs Assessment (PDANA) report consolidate on December 21, 2021 (Tuesday).
9. Installation of generator set within the Municipal Hall compound to generate temporary electrical power within the Municipal Hall.
10. Implementation of BAYANIHAN SYSTEM among BLGU, & MLGU. The MLGU to provide labor cost for chainsaw while BLGU to provide fuel for the chainsaw.
11. Submitted/ furnished reports to concerned agencies (DSWD & PDRRMO on December 18; DILG on December 19; SB on December 20).
12. Conducted meeting lead by Municipal Mayor and MDRRMO as needed arises together with LGU heads among others.
